REPORT OF PARTIAL RESURVEY OF COUNTY ROAD NO.515. THOUSE In Twp's 2 and 3 S., R. 63 W., Adams County, Colo.

Thursday, July 1, 1909.—Statted at a stone, which is the common corner for sections 22, 23, 26 and 27, Twp. 3 S. R. 63 W., of the 6th P. M.(Var. 15°E) run a random line North between Sec's 22and 23 and 14 and 15. At NE corner of Sec. 15 found a stone at a distance of 10,568 Ft., but about 60 Ft. E of random line. It was evident that the variation of 15°E. as given in the field notes was not correct for this portion of the line.

Friday, July 2, 1909.—Started at tewnship cerner cemmen to Twp's 1 and 2 S. and ranges 62 and 63 W., ran 2 miles W. and found well defined cerner with pits and mound en township line between Sec's 2 and 3 and in center of preposed county read.

Starting at this point with a variation of 15°E ran S.0° 15°E 5319.6 Ft. as per field notes. Found no indications of a corner but set tempetary stake.

Thursday July 1,1909----- Started at a stone, which is the common corner of Sections 22,23,26 and 27, Twp.3S.R.63W., of the 6th P.M. (var. 15° E.) run a random line North between Secs. 22 and 23, and 14 and 15, At N.E. corner of Sec. 15, found on a stone at a distance of 10,568FT., but about 60 ft.E. of random line. It was evident that the variation of 15° E. as give in the field notes was not correct for this portion of the line.

Friday July 2,1909.--- Started at township corner common to Twps. 1 and 2 S. and Ranges 62 and 63 W., ran 2 miles W. and found well defined corner with pits and mounds on township line between Secs. 2 and 3 and in the center of proposed County road.

Starting at this point with a variation of 15° E. ran S. 0° 15' E.5319.6ft. as per field notes. Found no indications of a corner, but set temporary stake.
