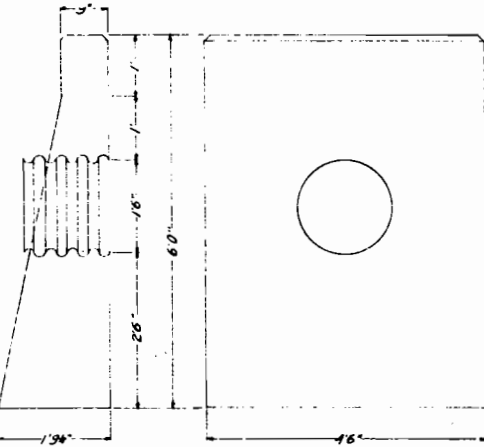

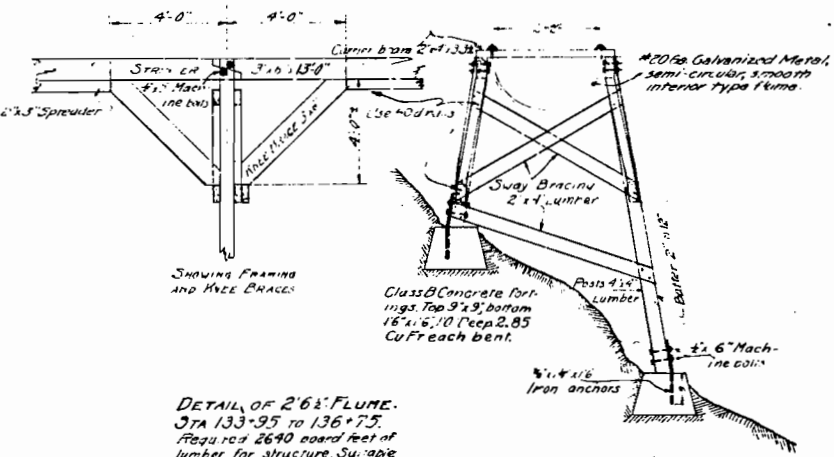

Required 3 Cu. Yds. Class B concrete for footings.

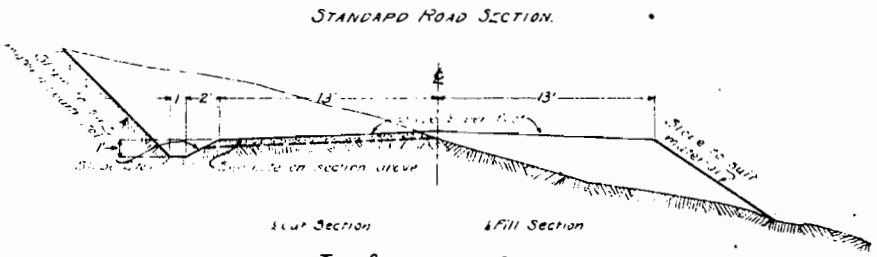


DETAIL OF ROCK DRAIN

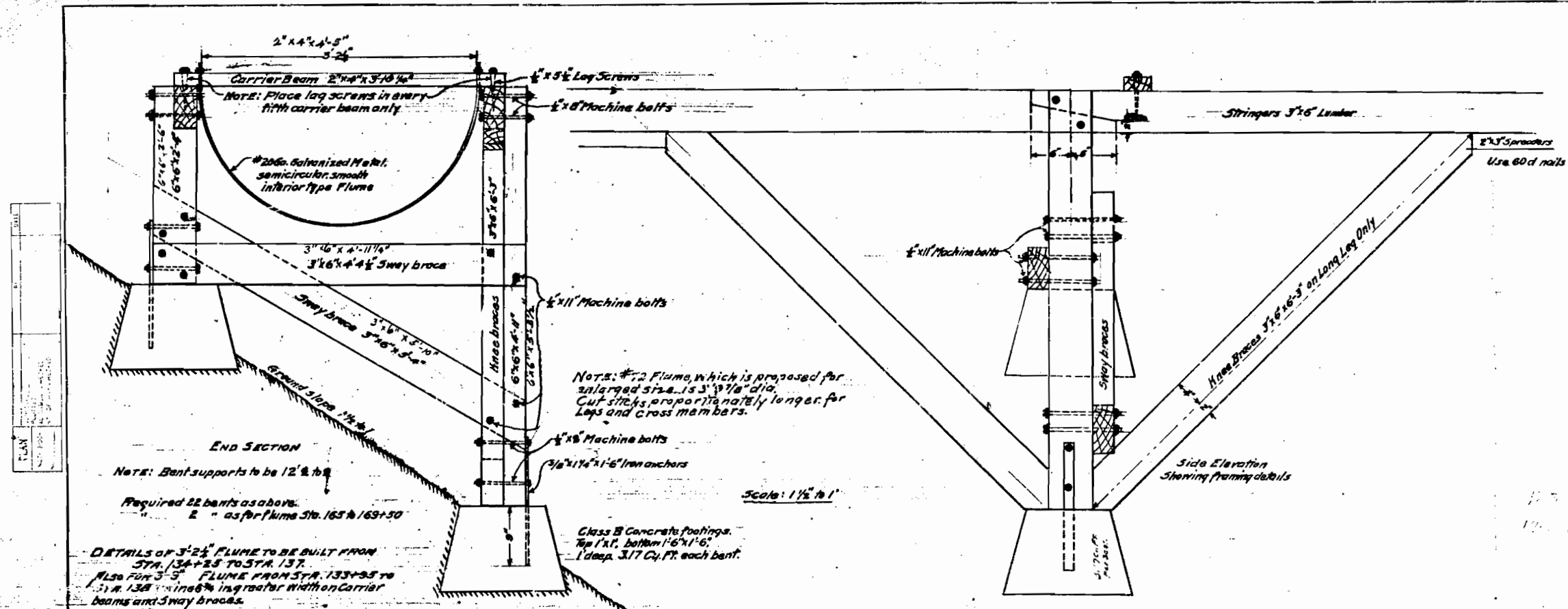

GENERAL NOTES  
All Cross Drains and Side Drains are to be provided with Standard Headwalls unless otherwise mentioned.  
Curves of under 1000 ft radius are to be super-elevated to a maximum of 1/4" per ft width of roadway. This is to be accomplished by moving crown of standard section to outside of curve; the change to take place within a distance of 100 ft, half on curve and half on approaching tangent.  
Where possible surplus excavation is to be worked in such a manner that a uniform widening of the roadway of curves to a maximum of 4 ft results.  
All Excavation outside of ditch section and slope shown on standard section is to be classified and paid for as Borrow Excavation.  
Borrow Pit Grades shown on Profile are to be followed except where changes will give sufficient material and provide suitable drainage of pits. When possible grades should be laid higher than grades shown.  
Grading Data shown on profile is to be considered approximate only.  
Clearing and grubbing called for on plans is to be considered approximate only. All clearing necessary on the right of way for the entire project is to be included in the lump sum bid for Clearing and Grubbing.

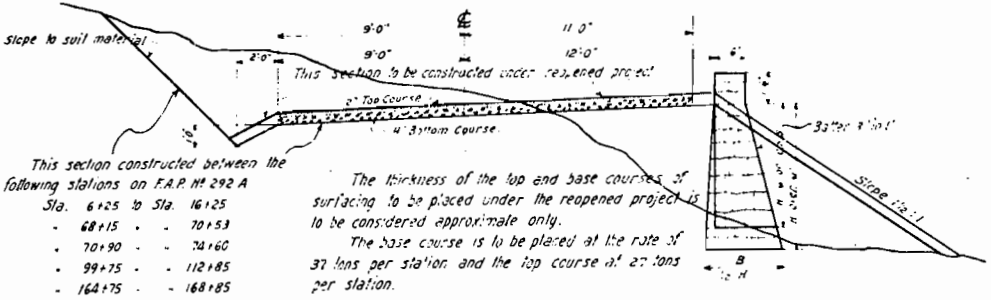

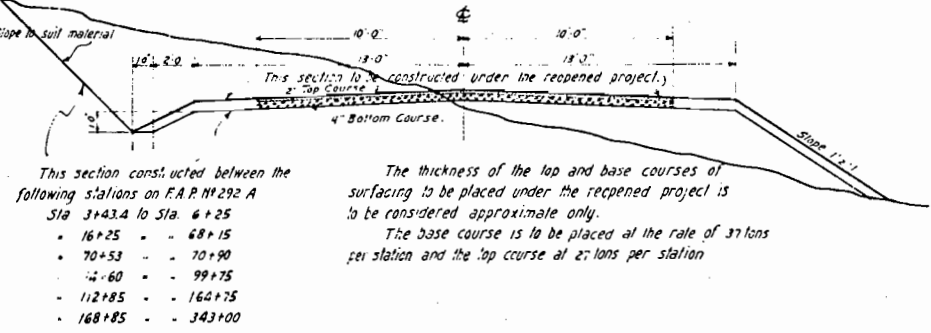
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TYPICAL CROSS SECTION OF IMPROVEMENT AND SUMMARY OF QUANTITIES

GENERAL NOTES.

This project is to be constructed in conformity with the Standard Specifications of The Colorado State Highway Department, adopted Jan. 1, 1930.

All quantities are to be considered approximate only.

Grading quantities on the reopened project are those required to build up shoulders as shown on the typical cross sections. prepare the subgrade for surfacing and grade the side ditches so as to improve the drainage. It is estimated that 25 Cu.Yds. of excavation per station of 100 ft. will be required between Sta. 3+43.4 and Sta. 36+00, and between Sta. 75+00 and Sta. 343+00, and that 100 Cu.Yds. of excavation per station will be required between Sta. 36+00 and Sta. 75+00.

Borrow Material required for the reopened project is available as shown in the table, "Sources of Borrow Excavation" together with the estimated overhaul on same. These figures include 100 Cu.Yds. of Borrow for raising grade by constructing a 400 ft. vertical curve Sta. 97 to 201.

The Department estimates that surfacing material for this project will be obtained from the vicinity of Pit #292 B.M. shown on title sheet. This plan involves approximately 21700 Tons of surfacing and 79000 Ton.Mi. of overhaul on gravel or crushed rock surfacing material. If the contractor, for his own convenience, elects to use a plan other than the above, overhaul in excess of that under the Department's plan will not be allowed.

Traffic is to be maintained over the project during construction. The contractor shall, at his own expense, prosecute his work in such a manner that traffic can readily pass over the road.

Stock piles of surfacing material, each to contain approximately 100 tons, are to be placed approximately one half mile apart as directed by the Engineer. This material is to be used in maintenance operations after completion of the project.

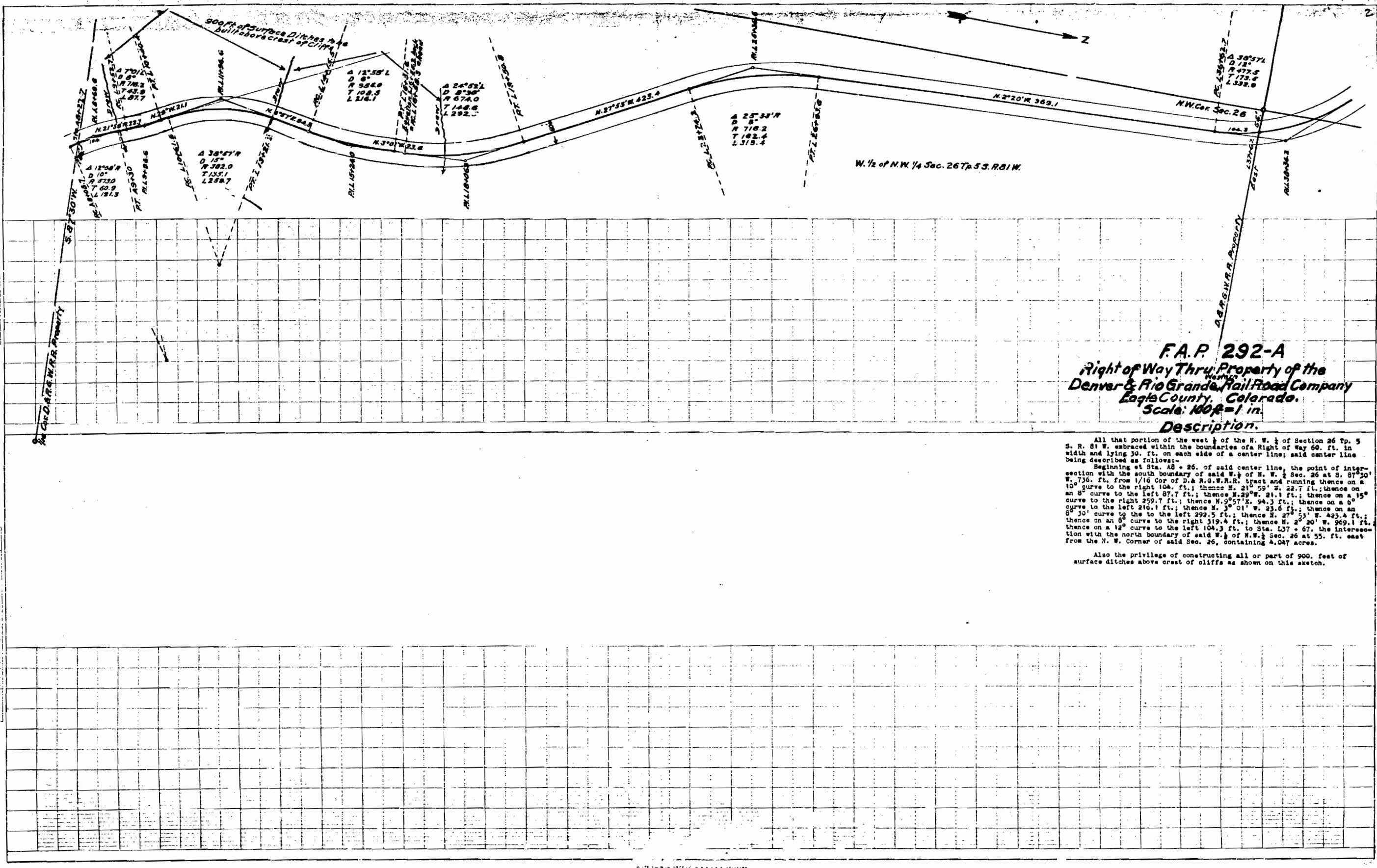

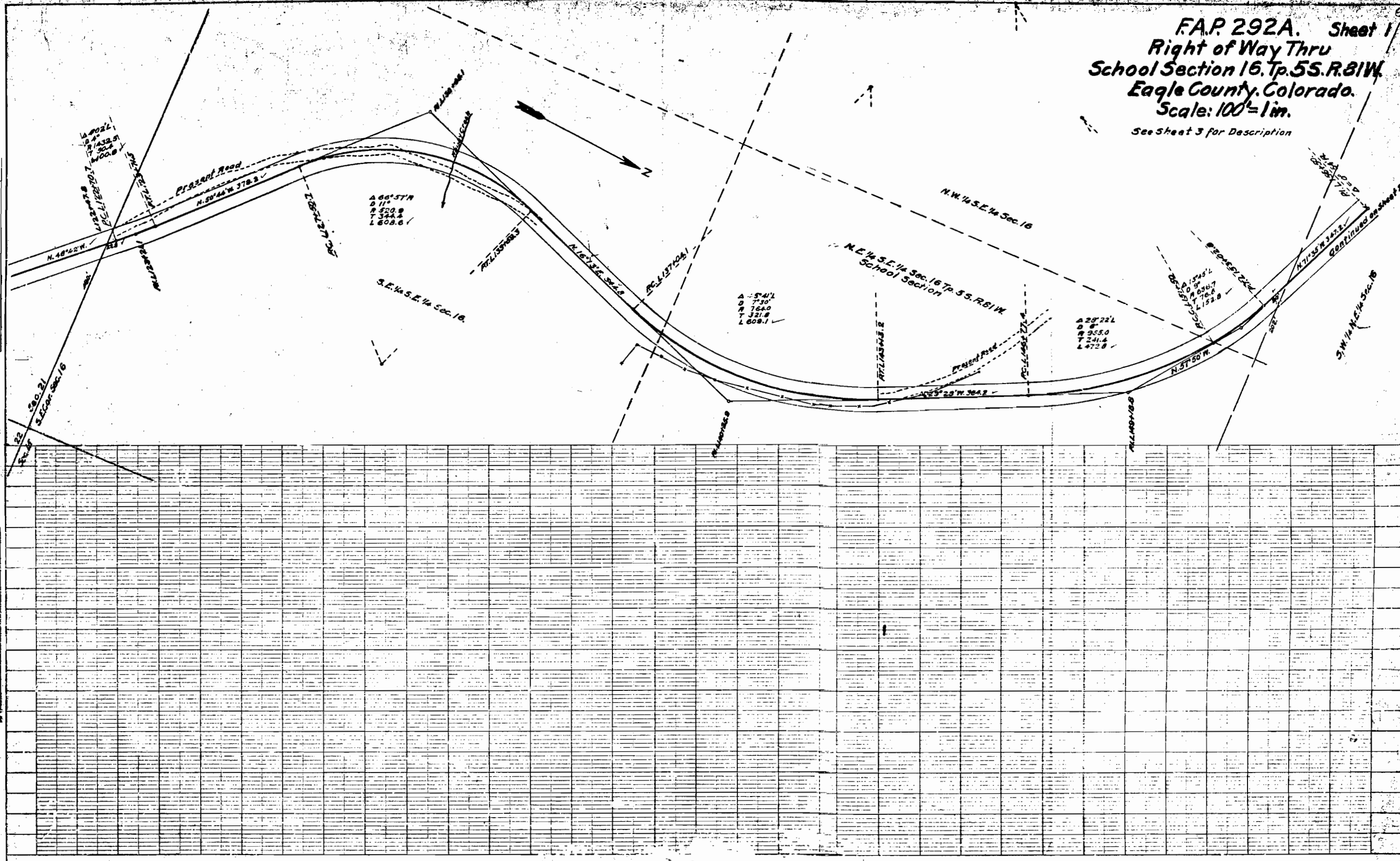




F.A.P. 292A. Sheet 1/

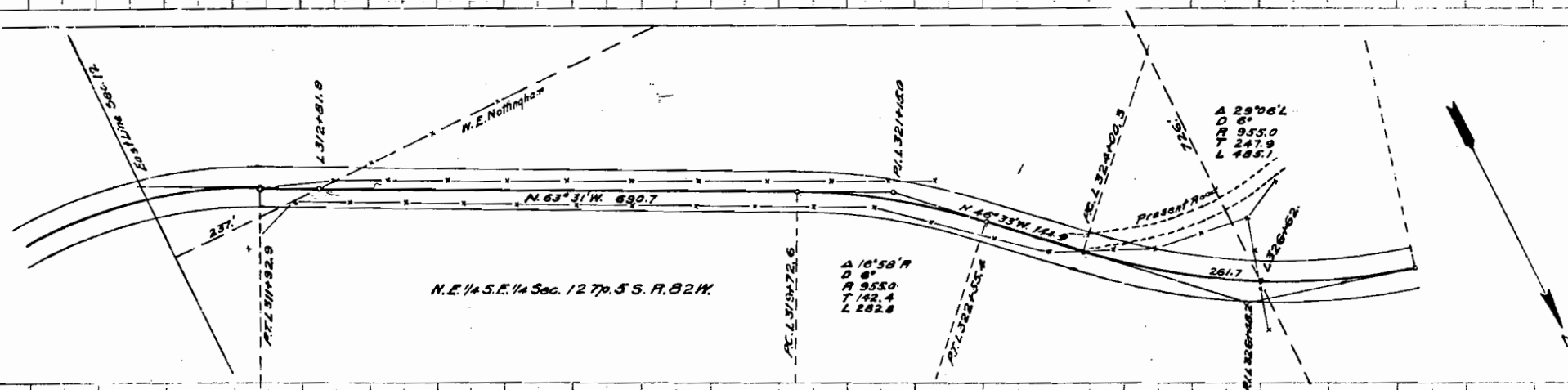

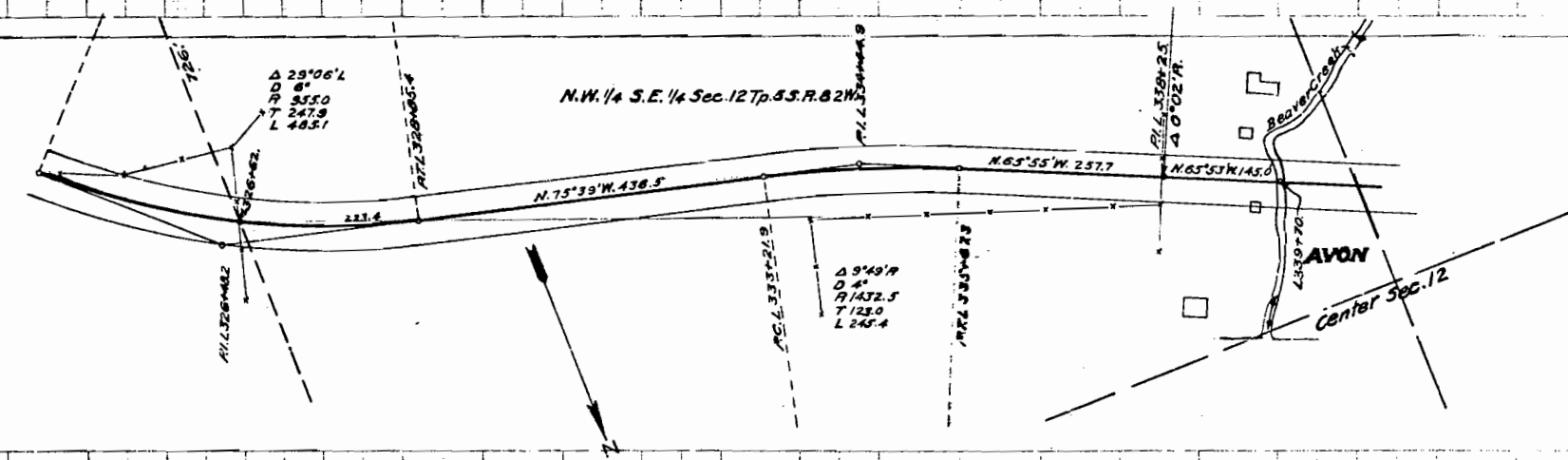

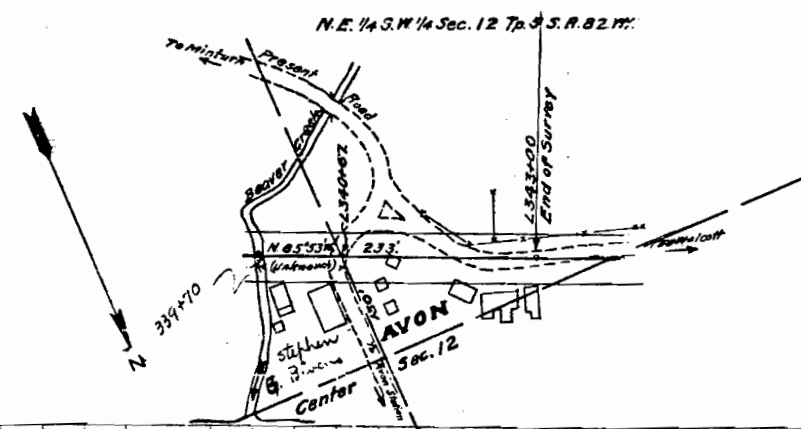
