DOUGLAS, Secretary of The Department of the Air Force, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Title 10, United States Code, Section 2668 (Public Law 1028, Chapter 1041, 84th Congress, 2nd session, 1956), having found and determined that the granting of this easement will not be against the public interest; that the terms thereof are advisable and that it does not include more land, or interests therein, than is necessary, hereby grant and confirm to THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS, STATE OF COLOrado, hereinafter designated as grantee, an essement for a right of way for road, street and highway purposes over, across, in and upon lands of the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter designated as grantor, under my control as Secretary of the Department of the Air Force, located in El Paso County, Colorado, identified as parcels 1 and 2, and more particularly described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

S. Highway 85-87, a freeway duly established according to the laws of the State of Colorado, within the control and jurisdiction of the grantee and is granted in consideration of a relinquishment, abandonment and vacation by grantee of portions of said highway at its former location no longer needed for such public use due to the requirements of grantor. Accordingly this essement is not subject to Title 10, United States Code, Section 2662.

CONTRACT FOR EASEMENT
BETWEEN
THE DEPARTMENT OF THE AIR FORCE
AND
COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAYS

THIS CONTRACT entered into this hith day of December

A.D., 1956 by and between the Department of the Air Force, U. S. A.,
hereinafter called the Air Force, and the Colorado Department of
Highways, hereinafter called the Highway Department, WITMESSETH:

WHEREAS the Highway Department is desirous of obtaining an easement for highway purposes through certain portions of the U. S. Air Force Academy: and

WHEREAS the Air Force is desirous of opening that portion of U. S. Highway 85-87 heretofore relocated within the boundaries of said Academy and is further desirous of closing the existing portion of said highway to permit further construction of facilities appurtenant to said Academy;

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the provisions and covenants hereinafter stated, it is mutually agreed as follows:

- 1. The Air Force hereby agrees to grant and convey to the Highway Department a perpetual easement for highway purposes over and across that property described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and over such additional property as may be required for other interstate highway purposes. Such easement shall be executed and delivered on behalf of the Department of the Air Force as soon as practicable, taking into consideration that complete title to the property over which such easement is to be granted is in the status of acquisition by the Colorado Land Acquisition Commission for subsequent conveyance to the Department of the Air Force in accordance with Memorandum of Understanding dated 19 August 1954 between the Colorado Land Acquisition Commission and said Department of the Air Force.
  - 2. The Highway Department hereby agrees to close that portion of the presently traveled U. S. Highway 85-87, open the relocated portion thereof, and authorizes the Air Force to destroy and remove such portions of the old portion as may be necessary for the purpose of constructing the Kettle Creek pressure conduit.

A strip of land 250 feet wide, 125 feet on each side of the center line. Center line description of Relocated U. S. Highway 85-87 as follows:

In Section 6, Township 13 South, Range 66 West; beginning at a point on the East line of said Section 2174.5 feet Bouth of the Northeast corner, thence Southwesterly along a curve to the left whose radius is 2865 feet, a distance of 769.5 feet to a point on the center line of U. S. Highway 85-87 as presently constructed.
