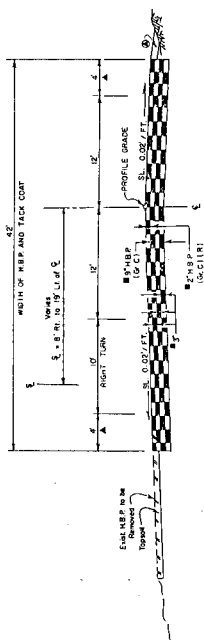

2. Luminaire tube furnished and installed by PSCO.
3. For street light luminaires on span wire installations - two (2) number 12 AWG copper TW insulated building wires shall be installed in the pull box and run to the luminaire through the pole along the span wire cable to the signal pole. The wires shall be run in the pull box with approximately 5 feet of extra wiring coiled in the pull box at the base of the pole.
4. For street light luminaires on mast arm installations - two (2) number 12 AWG copper TW insulated building wires shall be installed by the contractor from the end of the luminaire arm, through the pole, to the pull box. The wires shall be run in the pull box with approximately 5 feet of extra wiring coiled in the pull box. 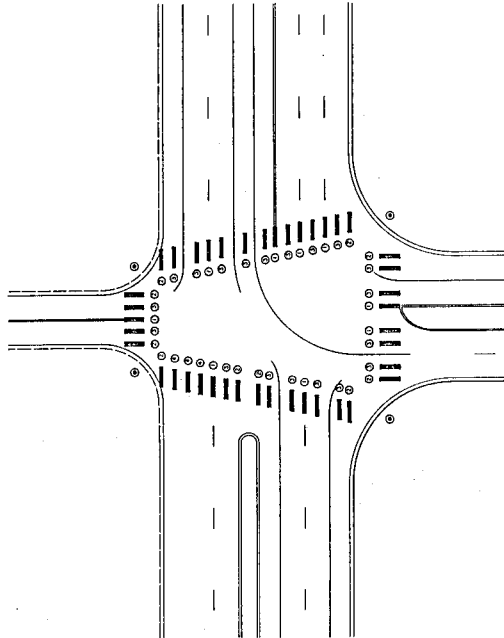
TYPICAL PAVEMENT MARKINGS LONGITUDINAL (CONTINENTAL) TYPE CROSSWALKS

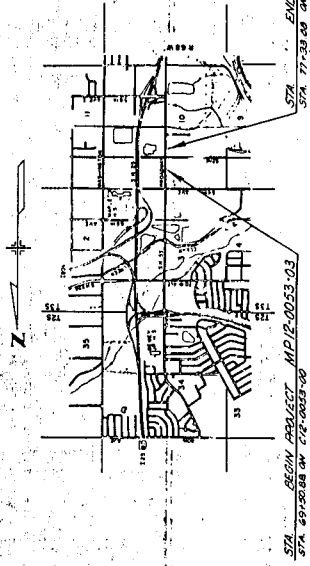
