## State Highway Statistics (2024)

These statistics apply to all Colorado Interstates.

Daily Vehicle Miles of Travel (DVMT) represents all vehicles traveling on every Interstate segment over an average day.

If a geographic area is not listed, there is no Interstate System Mileage for that area.
