

## State Highway Statistics (2022)

These statistics apply to all highways in Colorado including Interstates, United States (US) Highways, toll roads, and numbered Colorado Highways on the National Highway System (NHS).

Daily Vehicle Miles of Travel (DVMT) represents vehicles traveling on every segment of NHS Highway, over an average day. If a geographic area is not listed, there is no NHS System Mileage for that area.
